



William C. Ashil. State of South Carolina, Spartanburg District  
 To No 179. Know all men by these presents that S. William Ashil  
 Elishu P. Smith of the state and district aforesaid planter, for and  
 3rd. Dec. 1832. in consideration of the sum of ninety nine dollars nine  
 cents to me paid by Elishu P. Smith, merchant, of the state and district aforesaid and  
 for the better securing the payment of the same; have granted, bargained & sold and  
 by these presents do grant, bargain & sell, unto the said Elishu P. Smith, his heirs executors  
 or administrators the following property, viz, one black filly & cow & two cartings, ten  
 head of hogs, ten head geese, one cupboard, one chest, fifteen barrels corn, one dozen  
 sand bundles fodder, one syth & cradle, To Have & To Hold, unto himself, his heirs  
 or assigns forever, Provided allways nevertheless, that if the said Wm. Ashil, his  
 heirs or executors shall, do well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Elishu  
 P. Smith, the above mentioned sum, according to the true intent & meaning of two certain notes  
 of hand - then these presents, and this deed of bargain & sale, shall be null & void, & of  
 no effect, but in case of non payment of the above mentioned sum or any part thereof  
 or the interest thereon, or any part thereof, it shall & may be lawful for the said  
 Elishu P. Smith, at any time peaceably to enter into any & all the lands & tenements of  
 the said William Ashil & take charge, all & singular the above mentioned property  
 unto his own custody & possession & the same to sell & dispose of at his own will &  
 pleasure, returning the over plus, if any should be, after paying off the sum above  
 mentioned & cost of such sale or, vendue to the said Wm. Ashil. In witness  
 whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, and seal; this 27th day of January in  
 the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred & thirtytwo, in presence of us
